How To Setup OpenStage phones for myPortal for OpenStage

### 1 Prerequisites

Following prerequistes are required for myPortal for OpenStage.

- OpenScape Business installed and operating
- Embedded Web Server is enabled and operating
- UC Smart or UC Suite user is configured within OpenScape Business platform
- OpenStage device of the user is connected to OpenScape Business and operating.
- Actual Firmware (V2R0 or higher ) is installed within OpenStage 60/80 HFA device

### 2 SW Installation

No application software needs to be installed on OpenStage 60/80 device for myPortal for OpenStage, as the myPortal for OpenStage application is integrated part of OpenScape Business.

### 3 Administration / Configuration

#### 3.1 OpenScape Business Configuration

Access to the embedded Web Server of OpenScape Busniss has to be enabled. Administration of the Web Server access depends on the used UC solution within OpenScape Business.

3.1.1 OpenScape Business with UC Smart

Access to the Web Server via HTTP has to be enabled , as HTTPS is not supported by OpenStage phones. This can be done within Administration Portal by invoking the following configuration dialog:

- ➔ Enable UC Smart
- ➔ Allow Access via HTTP and HTTPS
- $\rightarrow$  Administrator or user has to set an individual password for the account

3.1.2 OpenScape Business with UC Suite

Access to the Web Server via HTTP has to be enabled, as HTTPS is not supported by OpenStage phones. This can be done within the Expert mode of the Administration Portal by invoking the following configuration dialog:

#### 3.2 OpenStage 60/80 Configuration

The following steps have to be done to set up myPortal for openStage XML application on openStage 60/80 (HFA) device.

- Enter administration menu of the phone or use an Internet Browser and the Web based Management (WBM) function of the phone.
- Browse to Applications  $\rightarrow$  XML applications  $\rightarrow$  Add application

- Enter the following parameter

# 4 Handling of myPortal for openStage

#### 4.1 Application Start

Select "Application" within the application menu by pressing the applications menu key of the phone Select myPortal within the list of available application using the TouchGuide of the phone



Start login procedure of the application by pressing the OK key of the TouchGuide myPortal application starts now and requests a password for login



Enter the password using the TouchGuide functions

After password has been entered select ok option within the menu and press the OK key of the TouchGuide.



If password is accepted the main menu of the application is displayed. You can browse through the main menu and choose the desired function using the TouchGuide functions.



Remark: The voicemail function shown here is only available in combination with UC Suite.

#### 4.2 Application Usage

The use of my Portal for openStage functions is intuitive. Once started, my Portal for open Stage is active until it is stopped manually. In case a phone call is initiated or alerting or other functions of the phones are used, application is put into background and is no longer displayed.



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To retrieve it from background, the myPortal application has to be selected again by pressing the application menu key of the device.

#### 4.3 Application Stop

Browse within the application menu using the application menu key and choose the myPortal application. Press the  $\rightarrow$  key of the TouchGuide, select Stop and press the OK key of the TouchGuide.



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
